The following list explains what is included in each of the options in addition to the conference:

**\*Single Rooms:** There are a limited number of single rooms. These will be allocated on a first come, first served basis. Single rooms carry a £5 supplement per night (already shown in the table)

**Ground floor rooms:** There are no lifts; please indicate on the registration form if you have a problem with mobility and we will allocate you a ground-floor room. Most of the ground floor rooms are for 2 or more to share.

**\*\*En-suite rooms:** Only 3 rooms are en-suite, but there are plenty of bathrooms throughout the building. All rooms contain wash basins. The en-suite rooms are on the ground floor and carry an extra charge of £7.50 per room per night. Please pay in advance if you would like one of these rooms – they are for 3 or 4 people but can be occupied by 2. If you are not allocated one of these rooms and have paid for them, £7.50 (or £15 for 2 nights) will be refunded at the conference.

**Drinks:** There is a tea room on site where drinks and light refreshments are available, and a bar which sells alcohol and soft drinks.
