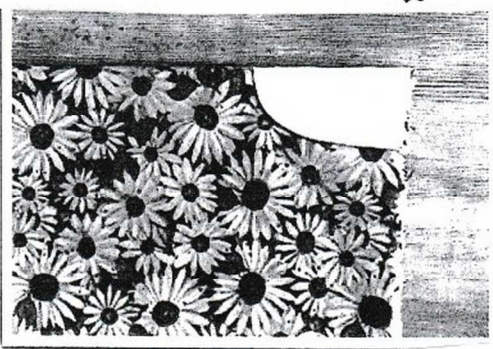

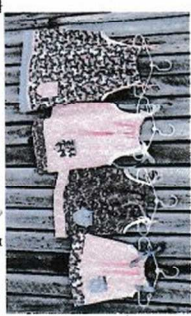

Little Dresses for Africa



(This is a suggestion sheet for those who wish to help with the project but don't actually sew. Bring your cut/pressed supplies in the zip lock bag back to the next DKG meeting.)

If using a pillow case, cut off the closed end. If using fabric, then pin the selvage on the inside to make a tube of the fabric - turn right side out and press. Select the template size and trace and cut your arm openings. * See picture at left for this. To proceed further, turn under 1/4 inch at the top front and back and press. Now press a 3/4 inch casing across the top of both the front and back. Now it is ready to be stitched to thread the elastic.

SUPPLIES NEEDED:

- 1 - Pillow case or 7/8 yard of fabric
- 2 - Armholes (cut)
- 3 - Matching thread
- 4 - 3/4 yard of matching bias tape
- 5 - 1 yard of 3/8 inch elastic
