Zodiac Mixer

Pre-planning:

Survey your members to determine their needs. This may be learning more about their devices (iPhones, iPads/Pods, Kindles/Nooks) social networking (Facebook, Twitter,) working with applications or websites (iPhoto, Shutterfly, Snapfish,) etc.

Survey your members as to who can present small group sessions. For example, topics may include "Make and Save Money with your iPhone," tablet, shutterfly, or iPhoto sessions.

Preparation:

Once you know your topics, secure your facilitators and send the information to your members so they can sign-up for a specific session. The number of groups will depend on your chapter needs. You can plan 1-5 sessions to run concurrently. Be sure your members bring their own devices.



Meeting Program:

Divide your members into the pre-determined groups. You can have just one session, or two depending on the time frame for your meeting. You may also have one large session, depending on the needs of your members.
