Broad Review of the *Logic Model*

Breakout Session 1: Exploring the problem and articulating the goal. Team identifies its problem statement with causes and writes their goals.

Breakout Session 2: Writing outcomes and measuring improvement. Team will write outcomes to match the overarching goal. Team must consider what evidence will constitute improvement while doing this.

Breakout Session 3: Inputs, Activities, Outputs: Teams will develop inputs (resources including personnel), outputs (concrete tangible products) and activities (what you need to do to reach your goal).
