Convention registration

Registration is a snap! Go to the dkg.org website to register or check the Jan/Feb issue of *DKG NEWS*. Your money goes farther when you register for the entire convention. However, you have the option of a one-day only registration. That includes any 24-hour period, Monday through Friday. To avoid a late fee, be sure to register by June 28th.

Indiana members will be assigned a table hostess responsibility for the Celebration Luncheon or the Friday evening banquet, taking into consideration whether they choose the full-convention registration or a one-day registration.

Members greeting at the airport or in the hotel on Saturday and Sunday do not need to register for those two days.

The one-day registration badge will be used for each day beginning with Tuesday. Those requesting oneday registration for opening night (Monday night) will have the same colored stripe along the bottom of the badge as for Tuesday.
