

The Pig

- A. Purpose: Participants get to know themselves in a fun way.
- B. Directions: Give each person a blank sheet of paper. Instruct them to draw a pig. Provide no further instruction.
- C. Interpretation:
 1. Pig drawn on top portion of page = An optimist; very positive
 2. Pig drawn in middle of page = A realist; factual
 3. Pig drawn on bottom of page = A pessimist; negative outlook
 4. Pig facing left = A traditionalist; friendly; remembers birthdays and dates
 5. Pig facing straight ahead = Direct; plays the devil's advocate; does not avoid issues
 6. Pig facing right = Innovative; action-oriented; not family or date-oriented
 7. Very detailed pig = Analytical person; cautious, suspicious
 8. Pig with little detail = Emotional person; bored by details; naïve; a risk taker
 9. Pig with four feet = Secure person; stubborn; has firm beliefs
 10. Pig with less than four feet = Insecure person or one going through major changes in her life
 11. The larger the pig's ears the better listener the person is
 12. And last but not least, the longer the pig's tail, the better the person's romantic life
