V. Approval of the Minutes of the May 3 & 5, 2013, Combined Spring Executive Board and General Membership Meeting

VI. Officers Reports:

A. State President, Liz VanWestenburg,

Liz reported that the theme for Alpha lota's 2013-2015 biennium is "Education: Our Focus, Our Future." This reflects several of the purposes of the Society and is tied to the projects and goals for the biennium. The first project is "Supporting Our Educators."
