- IV. <u>International Guest & Southeast Regional Director</u>- Cathy Daughtery brought greetings to the membership.

IX. Standing Committee Reports/Announcements

- A. Society Business, conducted by President Jacqulyn Smart.
 - 1. Lynne Elsesser, Membership/ Expansion, presented the following motion for the Executive Board.

"I move that the Executive Board dissolve the Alpha Iota Chapter and that the name Alpha Iota be held for future use." Carried.
