

The Hotel Saskatchewan is a local icon — and here are some important dates from its history:

1926 — Canadian Pacific announced construction of a luxurious \$1.5-million hotel in downtown Regina.

1927 — The Hotel Saskatchewan opened in May after 1,000 labourers worked 24/7 for 11 months.

1945 — With the conversion of Government House into a convalescent home for veterans, the Lieutenant Governor of Saskatchewan had a permanent office in the hotel.

1963 — CP announced a \$2-million renovation to the hotel.

1993 — The hotel was designated as a municipal heritage site. The Minnesota-based Radisson hotel chain signed to manage the hotel.

2002 — Hotel Saskatchewan Radisson Plaza receives the Regina Chamber of Commerce's Paragon Award for Customer Service Excellence.

2015—Hotel Sask to host the distinguished Delta Kappa Gamma Society International Regional Conference for a week of learning, sharing and networking.
