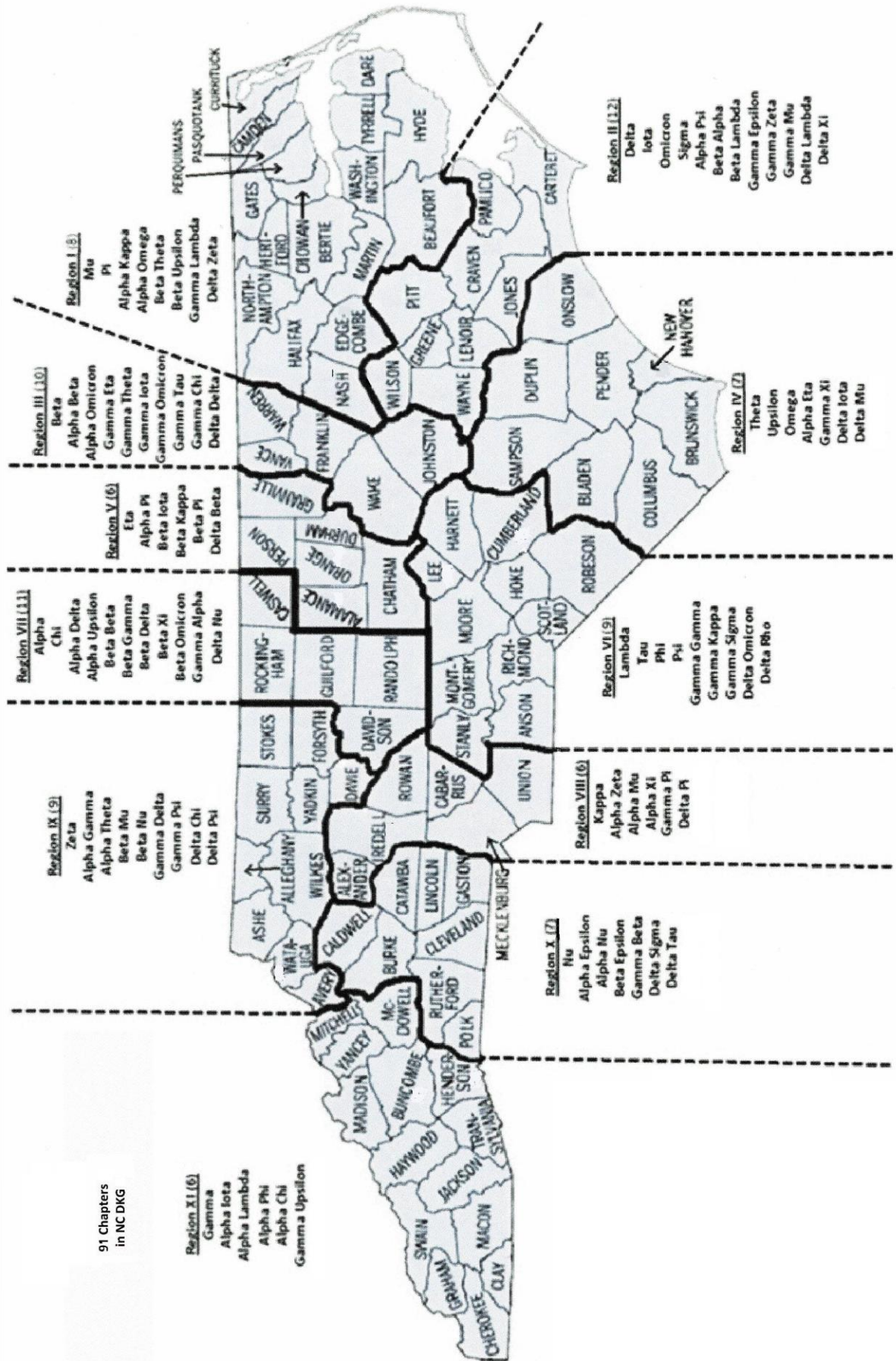

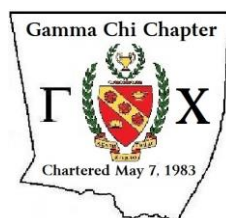
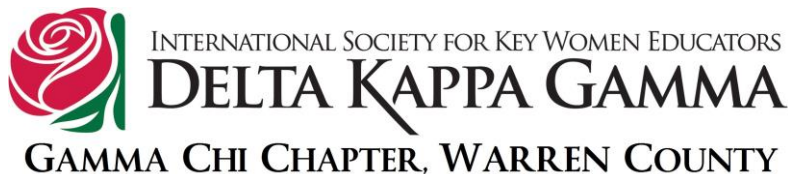

**DUTIES**

**Hospitality Chair:** To assist each group chair as needed.

**Group Chairs:** To plan and arrange a place for each meeting; to engage a caterer if having a dinner or decide what hors d'oeuvres to serve if no dinner; to delegate assignments to members of your group; to inform the editor before the newsletter deadline of the time, place and cost; to arrange, decorate, and set tables attractively; and to help with clean-up duties after the meeting. See next page for checklist of duties.

**Group Members:** To assist the group chair in all of her duties. Also each group member should provide at least one raffle item for their designated meeting.

**Each Member:** Check your email after receiving the newsletter for an invite to the meeting. Members should respond as soon as possible after receiving the invite. Members who have committed to attend and find out that they can't attend should notify the Communications & Marketing chair by the cut-off date in order to not be responsible for paying for the meal.



## **DKG Gamma Chi Hosting a Meeting Checklist**

1. Reserve a space. This should be done at least 2 months prior to the meeting.
2. Secure a caterer. This should be done at least 2 months prior to the meeting. Discuss the menu—cost should be limited to \$15.00. Find out how soon before the meeting (cut-off date) the caterer needs the tally.
3. Notify editor of the venue (address), menu, cost, and cut-off date at least four weeks prior to the meeting in order for this information to be included in the newsletter which normally goes out three weeks before the meeting.
4. Ensure A/C or heat is on at least 24 hours in advance.
5. Set up space: decorations, table cloths and podium
6. Tables are needed for;
  - a. raffle items
  - b. items being brought by members (September – new teacher bag items, December – children’s books, May – 1 for convention/celebration and 1 for induction)
  - c. small table for money/attendance at entrance
  - d. small table for raffle tickets at the entrance
  - e. 2 long tables for the food.
7. Identify a volunteer to collect money and take attendance. She should give the money to the treasurer if the treasurer is writing a check for the caterer. She should give the attendance to the recording secretary when finished. She should inform the treasurer of anyone who has not made payment after committing to come so the treasurer can pay for that member(s) and then recoup that amount from the member(s))
8. Contact everyone in your group. Assign duties for set up and clean up. Emphasize that each member is responsible for at least one raffle item. If not attending, raffle items should be sent to the meeting.
9. If at an unfamiliar location, place a sign to welcome everyone at the door
