Gamma Chi Chapter and its members have received many recognitions over the years including:

- **The Presidential Chapter Achievement Award**, the most prestigious award presented to a NC chapter, is given for chapter leadership, community projects, presenting scholarships and grants-in-aid, and contributions and support of International and NC DKG activities
- **The Communications Excellence Award** is given for accomplishments in greatly enhancing chapter communications
- **Founders Award**, received by one of our members, is given once every two years for making an outstanding contribution to the improvement of the quality of human life through education, research, publications or service
- **The Star of the Southeast**, received by one of our members, is given once every two years to a NC member at the DKG International Convention who has given distinctive service to her chapter, state organization, and community
- **Leadership Management Seminar Golden Gift Award**, received by one of our members, enabled her to attend an intensive two-week course to develop her leadership, management and communications skills; only 30 members of the Society are chosen every two years to participate in this seminar valued at over \$8,000
- **The Golden Key Award**, received by five of our members, honors NC members who have made significant contributions to DKG
- **The Rising Star Award**, a NC award received by four of our members, is given to newer members who demonstrate strong potential for successful leadership at the chapter and state levels and beyond
