- 5. **President's Report:** Cheryl Anderson (Delta) noted that the Chapter Presidents' would be giving an overview of their year. Each Chapter will have 2 minutes to share.
  - \*Alpha Chapter: Eva LeRud noted that this year was a challenge using Zoom. Participation decreased with members feeling more distant and less involved. Doris Nachtsheim and Wilma Birks passed away this year. Doris will be missed since she was an integral part of the Alpha Chapter.
  - \*Beta Chapter: Members Minnis Alderman and Claudia Gae Christensen passed away this year.
  - \*Gamma Chapter: Karen Laskowski reported that Linda Fleming was recognized as a 50-Year member. Gamma Chapter had a backyard meeting in September. Everyone missed the connections\*
  - \*Delta Chapter: Maxine reported that Delta Chapter met face to face outdoors in September and October. They have had virtual zoom meetings every month after that. President Cheryl worked very hard to help everyone enjoy a holiday each month including birthdays and other important events. Chapter members provided activities and learning opportunities for the Chapter. They also tried to continue their philanthropic activities as much as possible. Delta inducted two new members this year, Rosanne Anderson and Paige Coziahr. Member Kay Brown from Delta and Nu passed away this year.
  - \*Epsilon Chapter: Jennifer Neeman reported that Epsilon is having a virtual zoom meeting in March. They hope to have a planning meeting in April and a Founder's Day Meeting in May. We are inviting State President Cheryl Anderson to our May Meeting. We have had a difficult time this year because some members do not have internet. Member Ruth Golden passed away this year.

On April 26, Theta Chapter will be hosting their Annual Arts and Crafts Fair at Moana Nursery between 9am and 3pm.
  - \*Nu Chapter: Ann Dankworth is a first year President. She is also a nurse at Eagle Valley Middle School and was very busy this year with COVID-19 at the school. In September, the Chapter discussed giving each school \$25 for "Tenacious Teachers." The idea was tabled.
  - \*Omicron Chapter: Spring and Summer gift bags are planned for staff on Teacher Appreciation Day. A Give Away was planned for New Teachers. One half of Omicron members are full time teachers. helping to set up Zoom for Chapter meetings. Also, thanks given to Chapter Sisters for supporting each other during these difficult times. In October, Xi Chapter had an Octoberfest Sockfest as a community outreach for the Reno Veteran's Home. They had a luncheon of Brauts, Saurekraut, Potato Salad, Chinese Chicken Salad, and Chocolate Cake. Linda Beeghly presented a lesson on "Still Painting." In December, they had a Zoom Luncheon with sandwiches from Deli Town and a Hidden Christmas Picture Game. In January, they had a speaker on "Positive Healing." In February, they had a Guest Speaker. Each month, birthdays were celebrated. They did an outreach to Libby Booth School with a monetary donation. State Finance Chair Linda Getschman (Nu) applauded State Treasurer Heidi Hull for doing a great job and reported that Heidi always keeps her informed.

- 9. **State Website Report:** State Webmaster Cindy Frazer (Gamma) reported that the State Website was updated in September. There is now a "Memorial" page, an "Educational Excellence" page, and a "Kudos and Acclaims" page for members to post about others that the membership may want to hear about. President Cheryl will also be adding a "Rose of Recognition" page, and "Exemplary Awards" page, and a "NV Apple Awards" page.
- 10. NevadaGram Report: State Editor Gwen Anne Thacker (Delta) applauded Cindy Frazer for all her efforts on the website and reminded everyone to use the NV Alpha Chi State Website. The upcoming deadlines for the NevadaGram are May 1<sup>st</sup>, July 1<sup>st</sup>, and Sept 1<sup>st</sup>.
- 11. Educational Excellence & Nevada Apple Report: Pat Goeppinger (Gamma), Chair & Cheryl Anderson (Delta), State President. Pat Goeppinger (Gamma) reported that the Apple Award information was sent out in September 2020 to the Chapters. Information about Educational Excellence resources are available on the International Website regarding focus areas for Educational Excellence and Legislative information regarding educational issues.

- 12. **Communication's Report:** Communication Chair Maxine Emm (Delta) reported that Chapters having at least one Chapter Newsletter or a Chapter Website will receive an Honorable Mention Award for Communication. For 2019-2020, Honorable Mention was awarded to five Chapters: Gamma Chapter, Epsilon Chapter, Kappa Chapter, Lambda Chapter, and Xi Chapter.   Outstanding Awards for Communication are awarded to Chapters that have sent out 4 Newsletters to their members and have a Chapter Website. For 2019-2020, Outstanding Awards were presented to four Chapters: Delta Chapter, Theta Chapter, Nu Chapter, and Omicron Chapter. For 2020-2021, Outstanding Awards were presented to five Chapters: Alpha Chapter, Gamma Chapter, Delta Chapter, Theta Chapter, and Omicron Chapter.
- 13. Gold Key Report: State President Cheryl Anderson (Delta) reported that Chapters that met all 12 Key Points and 7 Polish Points to receive the Gold Key Award. The President keeps a score card of Chapter efforts.
  Honorable Mention Gold Key Awards went to four Chapters for 2019-2020: Alpha Chapter, Epsilon Chapter, Lambda Chapter, and Xi Chapter. For 2020-2021, three Chapters received Honorable Mention: Epsilon Chapter, Kappa Chapter, and Lambda Chapter. Five Chapters received the Gold Key Award for 2019-2020: Gamma Chapter, Delta Chapter, Theta Chapter, Nu Chapter, and Omicron Chapter. Six Chapters received the Gold Key Award for 2020-2021: Alpha Chapter, Gamma Chapter, Delta Chapter, Theta Chapter, Xi Chapter, and Omicron Chapter.
- 14. **Bylaws Report:** Marlene Killion (Omicron), Co-Chair & Gwen Anne Thacker (Delta), Co-Chair (ACTION REQUESTED/ADDRESSED IN UNFINISHED BUSINESS)
- 15. **Rose of Recognition Report:** Rose of Recognition Chair Pat Goeppinger (Gamma) reported that the presentations are ready and will be presented during the Awards Ceremony. For 2020, Rose of Recognition Awards went to Gemma Romo (Alpha), Cynthia Frazer (Gamma), Konnie McGruder (Delta), Penny Thompson (Epsilon), Charlotte Dinning (Theta), Jacita Rae Karr Young (Kappa), Martha Jessup (Lambda), Marie Bellard (Nu), Linda Beeghly (Xi), Heidi Hull (Omicron). For 2021, Rose of Recognition Awards went to Melinda Whitney (Alpha), Donna Harper (Gamma), Jill Harper (Delta), Dr. Judith Merz (Epsilon), Marilyn Naylor (Theta), Robbie Nickel (Kappa), Eileen Aragon (Lambda), Marlene Killion (Omicron).
- 16. **Exemplary Award Report:** Chair Pat Goeppinger (Gamma) reported that the Awards were ready for the Awards Ceremony. Maxine Emm (Delta) received the 2020 Exemplary Award and Doris Nachtsheim (Alpha) was Awarded the 2021 Exemplary Award (posthumously).
- 17. **Martha Schultz Doctoral Scholarship Report:** Chair Heidi Hull (Omicron) reported the previous recipient Susan Capistrant completed her Doctoral Program. Congratulations were given to Susan. There were no applicants for this year's Martha Schulz Scholarship.

- 18. **Annie Webb Blanton State Scholarship Report:** Chair Leta Rabenstine (Xi) reported that there no applicants for this year's AWB State Scholarship. Leta reminded everyone that the Scholarship is for Advanced Degree Work or attending Professional Seminars. Gemma Romo, the most recent recipient of the Scholarship, can speak to the benefits of the Scholarship.
- 19. **Emergency Fund Report:** Chair Marlene Killion (Omicron) reported that Nevada Chapters are contributing to the Emergency Fund. To request assistance from the fund, the applicant must have suffered loss in a natural disaster. The request is made to International through the State President. Nevada has contributed \$597. The following Chapters have contributed to the Emergency Fund: Delta \$140, Gamma \$132, Theta \$75, Alpha \$150, and Omicron \$100.
- 20. DKGIEF/Educational Fund Report: Karen Laskowski (Gamma), Chair & Dr. Judith Merz (Epsilon) Dr. Judith Merz (Epsilon) reported that the Educational Fund and the supporting corporation has merged into one. This included the Cornetet Award, Educational Projects, Educators Award Fund, Eunah Temple Holden Leadership Fund, Scholarship Fund, Golden Gift Fund, and the World Fellowship Fund. Treasurer Heidi Hull reported that the Nevada Alpha Chi State collected \$600 in the name of member Doris Nachtsheim. Nevada Alpha Chi State is currently collecting funds in the name of member Minnis Alderman for the Educational Fund. Dr. Judith Merz reminded that for tax purposes, one might want to contribute individually; but it was also noted that it takes a great amount of funds to benefit for tax purposes.
- 21. **Leadership Report:** Marlene Killion (Omicron), Co-Chair & Gwen Anne Thacker (Delta), Co-Chair Co-Chair Marlene Killion (Omicron) reminded everyone that the Executive Board has changed the Leadership Training to the Sunday after the State Convention. Odd years will be for State Officer training and even years will be for Chapter President training. Since the State Officers will be continuing for another biennium this year, there will be no training this year. Next year in 2022, Chapter Presidents will be trained.
- 22. **Southwest Regional US Forum Report:** Pat Goeppinger (Gamma), Nevada Representative reported that Daphne Cagle is the Southwest Representative for the US Forum. Topics that are being supported include Repeal of Social Security Payment Reduction for teachers and Mental Health in Schools.
- 23. Arts & Humanities Jury Report: Ardynne Sprinkle (Theta), Nevada Representative; & Cheryl Anderson (Delta), State President are entrusted with online publications and DKG member artwork. The next submission for online publication and artwork will be August 15 to September 15. Linda Beeghly (Xi) was recommended to submit her art. It was also noted that Judith Merz (Epsilon) has had several poems published on the DKG Arts and Humanities webpage including "Sweet Friend" and "Voice of the Poet" among others.

  It was also noted that political, patriotic, and diverse entries may not be accepted.
- 24. **World Fellowship Report:** Chair Pat Goeppinger (Gamma) reported that nineteen women from around the globe have received Scholarships and not necessarily just in education. The financial assistance is considered for support of their educational endeavors and are attending universities in the United States and Canada.
