The State's previous balance was \$7612.00 as of March 21, 2022, with deposits of \$2392; Beta dues \$140; Beta Savings \$100; Minnis' Memorial \$325; and Kitty's Memorial \$50. The current balance is \$8625.00.

The Permanent Fund has \$1991.29; Annie Webb Blanton Scholarship has \$7235.95; and Martha Schulz has \$30,069.89.
