Beginning with the July/August issue, the *DKG News* is now digital and all future issues will be available online only. Members can access the *DKG News* at <a href="https://www.dkg.org">www.dkg.org</a> by signing in with their member ID as username. This ID number can be found on your membership card. You can also refer to the address label of any International publication, though the number on these labels has one too many digits and you will need to drop the last digit. The default password is still dkg2014society. Once you sign in you will find the *DKG News* under Resources, Publications. If you wish to receive all International publications digitally simply sign into the My DKG area of the website and indicate your preference.
