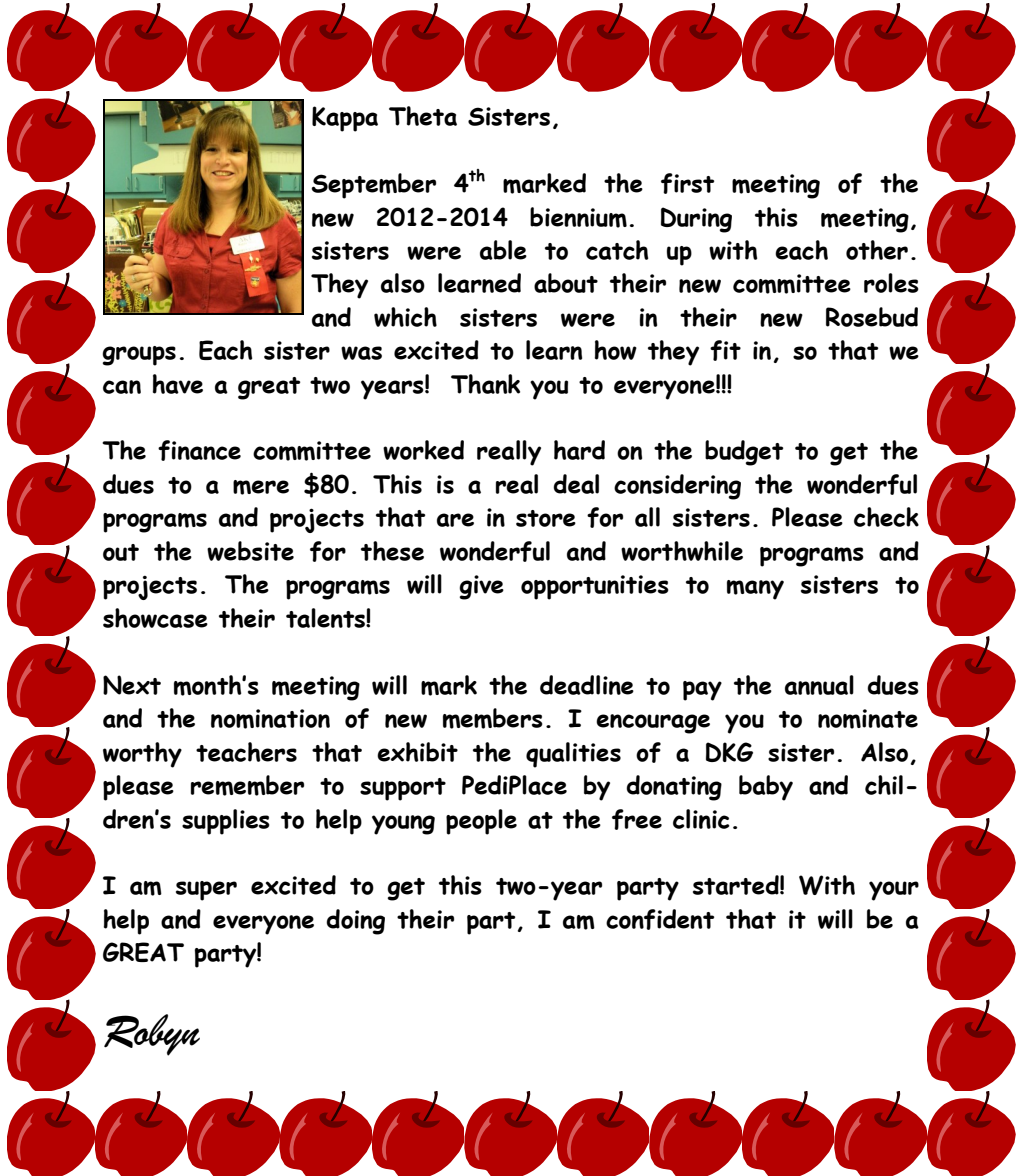

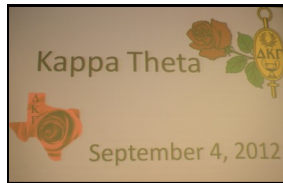

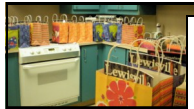
A Remembrance Ceremony was held to honor our beloved Marcie Cooley. Dowanne Jones prepared a slide show.



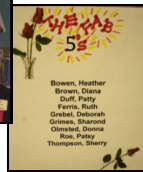
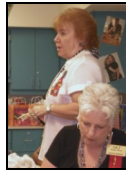

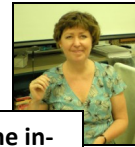

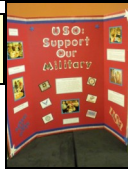
