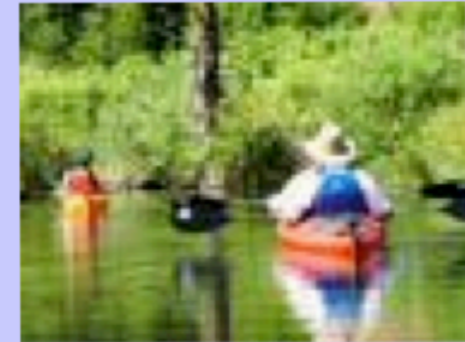

- *Visitors to Spokane have a choice of climates at any season of the year.*
- *Situated at the foot of a valley, midway between the rise and mouth of the Spokane River, it is 350 miles east of Seattle and 375 miles northeast of Portland, Oregon.*





The city is the commercial center of an agricultural region and serves as a gateway to the recreation areas of eastern Washington, northern Idaho and western Montana.

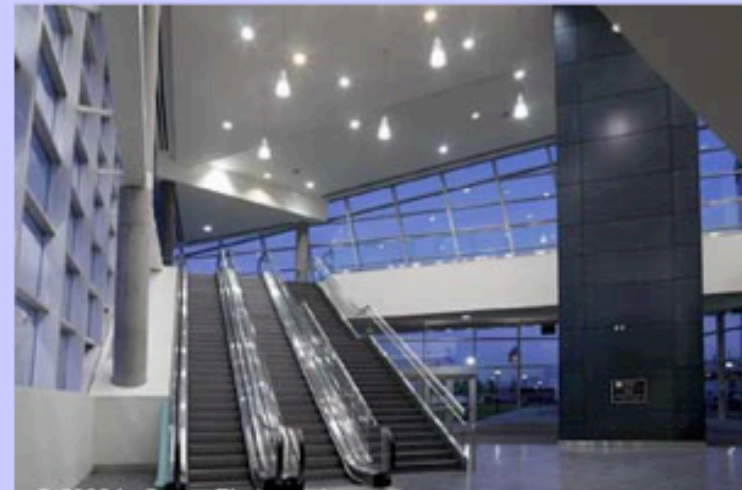

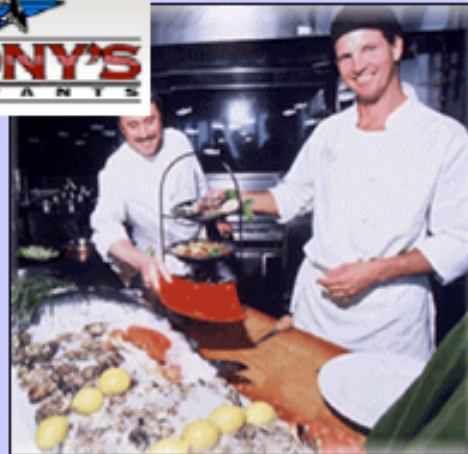

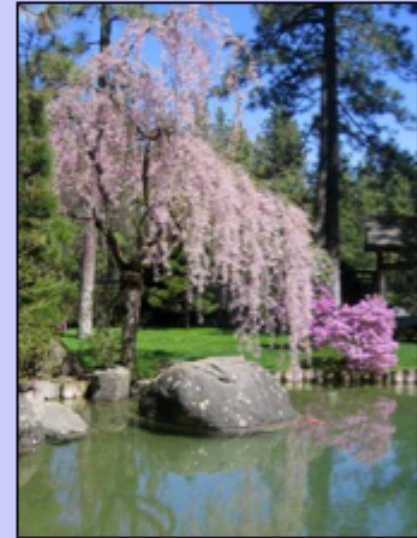

- Scenic sky rides over the Spokane Falls*

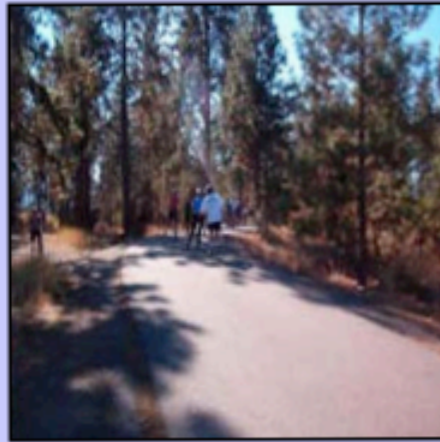




- *Nostalgic rides on the historic 1909 Loeff Carrousel*

- *An opportunity to cool off in the interactive water fountain or take a plunge on the giant wagon slide*



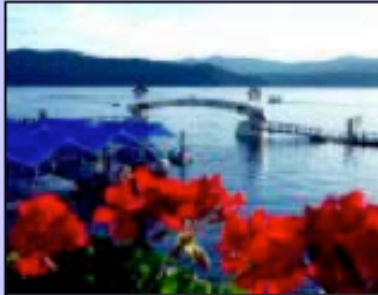

Enjoy the beauty of the rushing water flowing through the Upper dam near the Inn at the Park

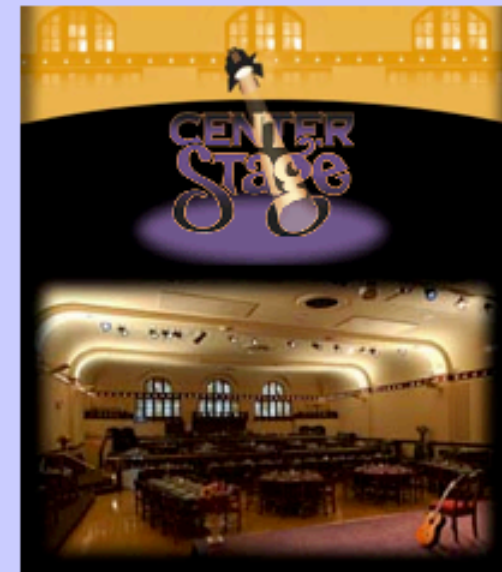

Experience the thrill of excitement at the glittering theme park in Sandpoint, Idaho just a one hour drive from downtown Spokane

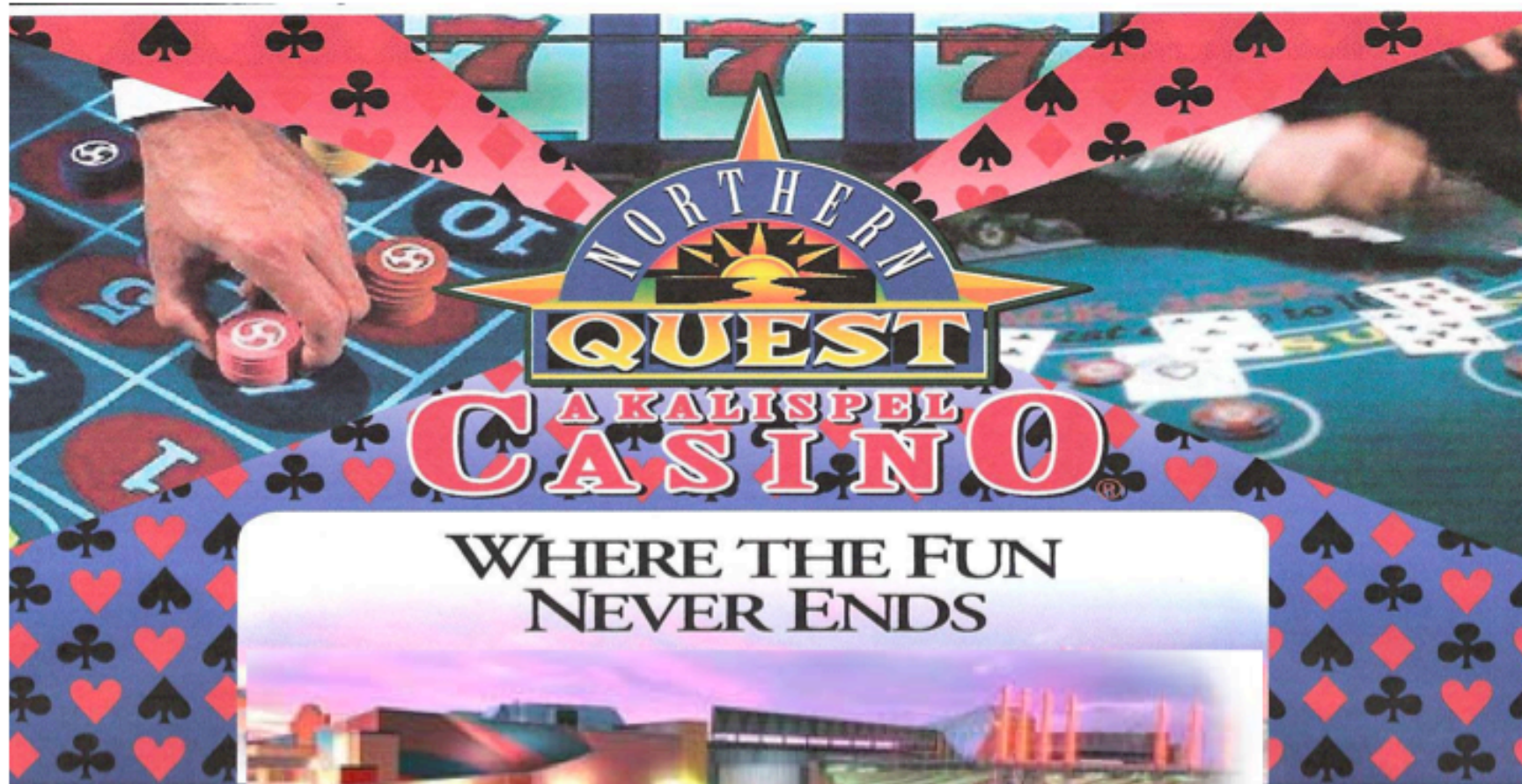

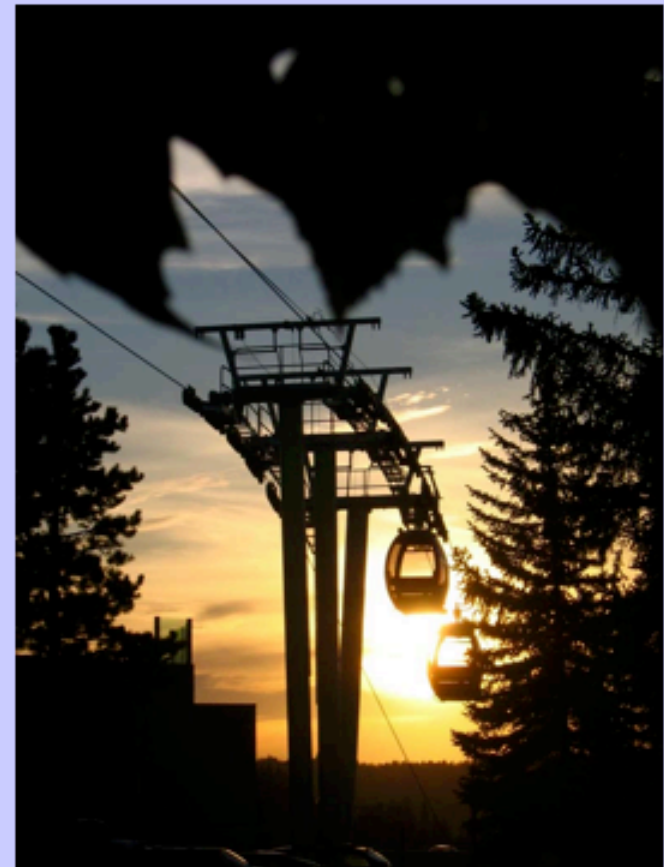
